I love Halloween. It is a time of joy and remembrance for me. When I sat down to reflect on what version of Hamlet, I have always wanted to see it as a production that fully allows an audience to embrace the haunting part of the story. I started to ask myself questions about why does Hamlet see the ghost of his father? What does it mean to be visited by ghosts? What type of place and time would ghosts walk the earth and have the need to speak? That led me to question my own thoughts about why and how as a society we grapple with the supernatural. Lastly, it made me question, more personally, who are those people whom I have lost in my life who I feel still speak to me and walk with me. These questions led me to this New Orleans reimagining of Hamlet where the supernatural and the physical coexist in order to reveal deeper truths that all the characters must grapple with.

I want to say thank you to my family living and dead who walk with me.
